Active Players on Roster

1. A team that had a full roster of 8 people but has lost a player, may request permission to replace that player. **At no time, however, may a team roster consist of more than 8 active players.** Teams may play up to 8 players per season, but only with the approval of the Executive Council (two-thirds approval vote of those Board members whose team is not involved in the player replacement) and as long their roster does not contain more than 8 active players. Any players replaced during the season are ineligible for League play for the remainder of the season.

The same procedural guidelines as for roster additions (Article VIII., B. 2. a-c) apply to requests for roster replacements.

Election Season

Elections:

- This is an election season.
- The floor is open for nominations during the first 3 weeks of the season.
- Candidates can accept nominations and "campaign" during weeks 4 and 5.
- Ballots are due back on June 29.
- Results will be announced on July 6th.

Friendly Reminder

Know the RULES and enjoy the game.
If it's NOT listed on the score sheet it didn't happen...
If in doubt, write it down...

Eligibility

Tournament: 5 matches or 17 games
Singles awards: 12 games
Overall awards: 30 games

Note - for a player to be eligible for league awards the player must meet the requirements for that category as outlined in the BCDL By Laws Article XIV: Awards.

Don't Do It

- ⇒ Don't use a player that has not been approved by the Executive Council (contact Ed Grubb ahead of time) and paid for.
- ⇒ Don't use a player in Doubles or 701 who was not listed to play and present during singles.
- ⇒ Don't forget to properly fill out the handicap data on the scoresheet (repeated mistakes result in penalties).
- ⇒ Don't fill out a cricket scoreboard on the scoresheet while its game is still in progress. You know who you are, and so do we.
- ⇒ Don't forget to read the front page of the newsletter each week before you start the match.
- ⇒ Don't forget to contact Joyce P. Owens (League Statistician) in

advance in case you need to reschedule a match.

- ⇒ Don't forget to be sportsmanlike, tip the bartender, and help clean up the empties.
- ⇒ Don't drink and attempt to drive.

Editor Notes

Packet drop off is still going to be **Down Under Pub ONLY**.

Scoresheets:

Remember, it is the *winning* team that is responsible for getting their scoresheet to **Joyce P. Owens**. It must have a Wednesday postmark if mailed, or be faxed by Wednesday to avoid penalties. Current penalties for late scoresheets are 5 points for a Thursday postmark or fax, 8 points for a Friday postmark or fax, and all points thereafter. The losing team should keep their copy. If the winning scoresheet is lost, the losing team will only get their points if they can produce their copy. The home team is responsible for picking the packet up before the match. It is the responsibility of both teams to verify that all information on the scoresheet is correct.

If any team needs to add a player throughout the season, they must first have the Executive Councils approval. Captains need to contact **Ed Grubb** to do this. Approval is required 72 hours prior to the first match played. After approval, the new person must then be paid for before they play.

Meeting called to order at 9:17pm

1) Division Make-Up: 16 teams signed up for the Summer 2004 season. Several divisional options were discussed (8-8, 6-10, 4-4-4-4, 6-5-5 and 6-6-4). Looking at the least number of byes and keeping a competitive grouping of divisional teams a motion was brought and passed unanimously for a 6-6-4 format. A division will have 6 teams, B division will have 6 teams and C Division will have 4 teams. The regular season will last ten weeks. A and B divisions will play two round robins in the regular season. C division will play three round robins and a position round (#1 vs. #4 and #2 vs. #3) in week #10, seeding as determined by points earned through week #9.

2) Playoffs. The top three teams from A, top three from B and top two from C will make the Championship Tournament. Determination of the top teams will be determined as defined in the Rules for Match Play. The remaining eight teams will be in the Consolation Tournament. Each match up in both tournaments will be drawn out of a hat. Home boards for the tournament will be determined as follows: in the Championship Tournament, the top three rankings will go to the division winners and the remaining five rankings will be determined by point totals (tie-breaking as determined in the Rules of Match Play). The eight teams in the Consolation Tournament will be ranked by point totals. <Side note: There was discussion about using either a 'neutral board' format or having the lower ranked team have the home board advantage for the tournament, but the Council was so divided on the topics that there was no motion or vote to change the home board format. > With a ten week season and three weeks of playoffs, the regular season will end July 20th and the Tournaments will be completed August 10th. <Although it was not discussed the End of season party is tentatively scheduled August 14th, Location TBD. >

3) New Business Item 1: Andy Mead brought up that the BCDL has not sold league T-shirts in some time and requested if the league would consider fronting the costs for 80-100 shirts of various sizes that could be sold throughout the next few seasons. Andy Mead has contact with the last T-shirt printer the BCDL used; the logo (designed by V. Cullum Rogers) is still on file. Wade Moricle stated he is already looking into T-Shirts for the Bull City Classic. In an effort to avoid duplication of efforts, the issue was tabled; Andy Mead offered his assistance and contacts when the Council sees fit to revisit the issue.

4) New Business Item 2: Motion to change the handicap points, a change to the Rules for Match Play. Andy Mead brought up that the handicap system is not effective for making fair competition. He brought up two potential motions he felt would correct this: the first making the handicap assessed 20 points per HCCP differential for all games. After a quick heated discussion, the Council immediately rejected this potential motion. Andy Mead then brought the motion of changing the handicap allotment: Singles 301 - no change remain at 15 points per HCCP differential, Singles Cricket - change to 20 points per HCCP differential (presently 15), Doubles 601 - no change remain at 15 points per HCCP differential, Doubles Cricket - change to 15 points per HCCP differential (presently 10),

Four-Person 701 – change to 15 points per HCCP differential (presently 10).

The motion was seconded by Wade Moricle and passed a council vote 4-1 (For: DJ, WM, ED, JS; Against: JR). This change to the rules for match play will take effect this season.

Meeting was adjourned at 11:39 pm.
