Active Players on Roster

1. A team that had a full roster of 8 people but has lost a player, may request permission to replace that player. **At no time, however, may a team roster consist of more than 8 active players.** Teams may play up to 8 players per season, but only with the approval of the Executive Council (two-thirds approval vote of those Board members whose team is not involved in the player replacement) and as long their roster does not contain more than 8 active players. Any players replaced during the season are ineligible for League play for the remainder of the season.

The same procedural guidelines as for roster additions (Article VIII., B. 2. a-c) apply to requests for roster replacements.

Friendly Reminder

Know the RULES and enjoy the game.

If it's NOT listed on the score sheet it didn't happen...

If in doubt, write it down...

Eligibility

Tournament: 6 matches or 19 games

Singles awards: 14 games

Overall awards: 33 games

Note - for a player to be eligible for league awards the player must meet the requirements for that category as outlined in the BCDL by Laws Article XIV: Awards.

Don't Do It

- ⇒ Don't use a player that has not been approved by the Executive Council (contact Pete Hall ahead of time) and paid for.
- ⇒ Don't use a player in Doubles or 701 who was not listed to play *and* present during singles.
- ⇒ Don't forget to properly fill out the handicap data on the scoresheet (repeated mistakes result in penalties).
- ⇒ Don't fill out a cricket scoreboard on the scoresheet while its game is still in progress. You know who you are, and so do we.
- ⇒ Don't forget to read the front page of the newsletter each week before you start the match.
- ⇒ Don't forget to contact Joyce P. Owens (League Statistician) in advance in case you need to reschedule a match.
- ⇒ Don't forget to be sportsmanlike, tip the bartender, and help clean up the empties.
- ⇒ Don't drink and attempt to drive.

Editor Notes

Packet drop off is still going to be **Down Under Pub ONLY**.

Scoresheets:

Remember, it is the *winning* team that is responsible for getting their scoresheet to **Joyce P. Owens**. It must have a Wednesday postmark if mailed, or be faxed by Wednesday to avoid penalties. Current

penalties for late scoresheets are 5 points for a Thursday postmark or fax, 8 points for a Friday postmark or fax, and all points thereafter. The losing team should keep their copy. If the winning scoresheet is lost, the losing team will only get their points if they can produce their copy. The home team is responsible for picking the packet up before the match. It is the responsibility of both teams to verify that all information on the scoresheet is correct.

If any team needs to add a player throughout the season, they must first have the Executive Councils approval. Captains need to contact **Pete Hall** to do this. Approval is required 72 hours prior to the first match played. After approval, the new person must then be paid for before they play.

Scheduling Meeting

Jason Kilts, Randy Wilcox, Pete Hall, Jerry Shengulette, Paula Brown and John Strobel are in the house. Darrell Coleman is absent.

Also in attendance, Steve Turner, Eddie Jackson, Bob Rankl, Joyce Owens, Mike Litzsinger, Brett Leyburn, Don Richards and Sean O'Brien. My apologies to others who may be popped in; my back was to the entrance.

Mike Litzsinger would like to see the dues lowered to \$20 since the reason for the original increase (to pay for new software) has passed. Pete says we're not losing money. Much discussion of finances follows ending with the conclusion that we're pretty stagnant. Vote to return individual dues to \$20: Paula abstained. Pete, Jerry, Jason, John, Randy in favor. Effective next season.

It was determined that there was no pressing need for Paula to recheck any boards this season. Naturally, if someone has a concern they should contact Paula.

We have 18 teams. We'll be breaking into 3 divisions of 6. The schedule will be a double round robin. The midseason Captains Meeting/LOD was well received and will be repeated.

Captains Meeting to be held on Tuesday, February 15, 2005 at Arnie's beginning, 7-9pm. A LOD will follow.

The Season 35 Awards Banquet will be held the weekend of April 23/24. The details are TBD by Darrell Coleman.

8 teams will qualify for the Mug tournament. The remaining 10 teams will be eligible for consolation tournament. The top 2 finishers (points) in each division will qualify for the playoffs. Wildcard teams will have the next 2 highest season point totals. Playoff pairings and sites will again be determined by blind draw. As far as sites go, each team is given a "chip" in the hat and once their chip is selected there is no replacement. Seedings (for designating "home" team) will be 1-2-3 for division winners and thereafter based on season point totals.

A division: Whatever, AWOL, Poke 'n Hope, Chapel Hill Boyz, Some People's Kids..., Flight of the Puppies

B division: Have Darts Will Travel!, Wet 'n Ready, Stop the Mathness, Projectile Dysfunction, Darts? Nah, To Be Dee-terminated

C division: West End II, Sticky Fingers, Strokin', Bivowacked, Inside the Wire, Wall Bangers

Naturally not everyone will be happy but the board did put some thought into this. Below are some of the points of discussion. Feel free to complain but the best way to voice your opinion is to attend the Scheduling Meeting.

- AWOL got to stay in A by virtue of not finishing last in A last season

- Chapel Hill Boyz have a standing request to play in A and thus remained there despite a last place finish that might have gotten them some B consideration.
- Poke 'n Hope got promoted to A by virtue of recent regular season and playoff success
- Projectile Dysfunction (Rankl, Turner, et al) requested to be in B division and every effort was made to accommodate
- Wet 'n Ready and Bivowacked (Brown, Richards, et al) swapped division based on last season's finishes.
- Ultimately one more team needed to move from B to C. Sticky Fingers – the defending champs – was chosen due to 50% roster turnover..

The regular season ends March 22. The end of the playoffs will be determined by how many teams actually elect to participate in the consolation tournament (which could run 1 week longer than the Mug Tournament).

Randy suggests 2-out-of-3 instead of 1 and done for individual playoff games. Consensus was that 1) would take too long and 2) make it harder for the lower player to steal a victory.

Bob Rankl brought up 701 again to its usual guffaws. Bob wants 701 to be worth 1 point. He feels the current setup penalizes better team because '01 game is more easily an upset. Alternatively, he suggests perhaps working in some form of cricket; maybe the team that wins the diddle could elect to play Australian Cricket instead of 701.

Jason offered a concurring view that 701 was indeed a little messed up. The recent changes raising the handicap factor from 10 to 15 in the 4-man game was making the starting point gaps too great. He proposed playing 801 instead of 701.

In the end, Bob really just wants something that works better so he went along with Jason's thinking.

The board voted to change the 4-man handicap factor from 15 to 10. Pete, Randy, Paula, Jason, Jerry voted FOR. John ABSTAINED.

The board voted to change the 4-man game from 701 to 801. Jerry, Jason, Randy voted FOR. Paula and Pete voted AGAINST. John ABSTAINED.

Jason presented the argument that the Doubles Cricket handicap factor should be

exactly ½ the Singles Cricket handicap factor. The board voted to change the Doubles Cricket handicap factor to 10. Pete, Randy, Paula, Jason, Jerry voted FOR. John ABSTAINED.

Jason would like us (board members) to independently track when our various singles games get to the out (bull or 40). This would form the basis of our sliding scale. Board members have agreed to monitor this during their matches.

Mike Litzsinger wants to see if we can consider awarding some incentive for a match win. Pete says maybe a point per win. Jerry, Randy, Paula, Strobel opposed. Jason opposed to prevent sandbagging by dumping all your singles and then winning the others. TABLED. Will bring it up at the captains meeting.
