Active Players on Roster

1. A team that had a full roster of 8 people but has lost a player, may request permission to replace that player. **At no time, however, may a team roster consist of more than 8 active players.** Teams may play up to 8 players per season, but only with the approval of the Executive Council (two-thirds approval vote of those Board members whose team is not involved in the player replacement) and as long their roster does not contain more than 8 active players. Any players replaced during the season are ineligible for League play for the remainder of the season.

The same procedural guidelines as for roster additions (Article VIII, B. 2. a-c) apply to requests for roster replacements.

Friendly Reminder

Know the RULES and enjoy the game.

If it's NOT listed on the score sheet it didn't happen...

If in doubt, write it down...

Eligibility

Tournament: 5 matches or 17 games

Singles awards: 12 games

Overall awards: 30 games

Note - for a player to be eligible for league awards the player must meet the requirements for that category as outlined in the BCDL by Laws Article XIV: Awards.

Don't Do It

- ⇒ Don't use a player that has not been approved by the Executive Council (contact Pete Hall ahead of time) and paid for.
- ⇒ Don't use a player in Doubles or 701 who was not listed to play and present during singles.
- ⇒ Don't forget to properly fill out the handicap data on the scoresheet (repeated mistakes result in penalties).
- ⇒ Don't fill out a cricket scoreboard on the scoresheet while its game is still in progress. You know who you are, and so do we.
- ⇒ Don't forget to read the front page of the newsletter each week before you start the match.
- ⇒ Don't forget to contact Joyce P. Owens (League Statistician) in advance in case you need to reschedule a match.
- ⇒ Don't forget to be sportsmanlike, tip the bartender, and help clean up the empties.
- ⇒ Don't drink and attempt to drive.

Editor Notes

Packet drop off **Down Under Pub ONLY.**

Scoresheets:

Remember, it is the *winning* team that is responsible for getting their scoresheet to **Joyce P. Owens**. It must have a Wednesday postmark if mailed, or be faxed by Wednesday to avoid penalties. Current penalties for late scoresheets are 5 points for a Thursday postmark or fax, 8 points for a Friday postmark or fax, and all points thereafter. The losing team should keep their copy. If the winning scoresheet is lost, the losing team will only get their points if they can produce their copy. The home team is responsible for picking the packet up before the match. It is the responsibility of both teams to verify that all information on the scoresheet is correct.

If any team needs to add a player throughout the season, they must first have the Executive Councils approval. Captains need to contact **Pete Hall** to do this. Approval is required 72 hours prior to the first match played. After approval, the new person must then be paid for before they play.

Registration / Scheduling Meeting - Spring 2005

Not much happens at the Registration Meeting, really. I arrived at 7pm, just in time to watch the credits roll on Charmed. At this point "slow sports night" is my primary concern. As soon as people started arriving it was just a blur of roster recording, board assigning, rookie recognizing and team name critiquing.

Some highlighted discussion points from random conversations:

- 1) The back room (where boards 9&10 were) is no longer available at Arnie's. Its former users, Chapel Hill Boyz and Puppies – hmmm, there's an unfortunate turn of phrase –

have selected other boards at Arnie's.

- 2) Some old bars are returning to the fold. We have teams playing out of Doyle's and the Down Under Pub.
- 3) Bob Rankl, voiced tonight by fellow Dysfunctional and early withdrawer (heh heh) Steve Turner, is **still** opposed in principal to the 4-on-4 '01 game being worth 3 points.
- 4) This being the "Summer" season, the board is leaning toward trying something "different" but no one has a firm idea of what that is.
- 5) With the unexpected on-time– early even – arrival of a Chapel Hill Boyz representative, we have 18 teams.

Season 36 Scheduling Meeting

The meeting is called to order at 9:02pm (by the clock on my laptop). After some brief discussion we move to the pool table room.

In attendance are:

Council members - Jason Kilts, Paula Brown, Pete Hall, John Strobel, Jerry Shengulette, Dee Marx and Randy Wilcox.

League members – Mike Litzinger, Anthony Jones, James Mathewson.

Others were in and out over the course of time.

Finances

Treasurer Pete Hall opened with a recounting of the league finances. Specific details are available from Pete upon request. I'm not entirely comfortable airing this part of our laundry to the world so I'll just summarize liberally. According to the paperwork presented, the league lost \$750 last season.

This is tempered by the unusual circumstance of having to pay for the Season 34 party and some of that season's trophies. Limiting our focus to just Season 35 the league closed roughly \$400 in the black. This includes matching money for the mid-season LOD.

With the reduction in dues, we will probably be up \$100 this season. Again, contact Pete Hall if you are interested in the details.

Party Reviews

Party at West End was a "great time" (John Strobel). Overall positive reviews. Food was good.

Party location will be up to Dee this season and she is leaning toward a return to the West End.

Bull City Classic

The Bull City Classic is on this year (in Cary at the Upper Deck). June 3-5. Jason is the tournament director so he is serving an information role and abstaining from any vote. The tournament – our signature tournament – needs some sponsorship. Typically \$50-100 is standard from corporate sponsors. Sometimes groups sponsor one of the event (singles cricket, etc.) in the higher dollar amounts.

Jason suggests that the easiest thing to do is to put up an amount and let the tournament coordinators decide what to do with the funds.

Paula suggests \$250. Dee seconds.

Yeah: Pete, John, Dee, Jerry, Paula, Randy
Nay:
Abstain: Jason

Rule changes:

There are no rule changes on anyone's mind at this point. Dee asks if we have a hard and fast rule about divisional assignments being based on order of finish in the prior season (ie. 1st place B goes to A, last place B goes to C, etc.). We do not have such a rule on the books. From season to season our rosters are generally too fluid to make this equitable. Additionally, we attempt to honor reasonable requests so if, for example, the Chapel Hill Boyz generally request to play in the A division regardless of their earlier finish.

John requests pdf files for scoresheets and registration forms. Jerry to get with Joyce on this item.

The Chart

Throughout the most recent consolation tournament, participating teams were provided with a chart to figure out handicaps to use based on the skill levels and relative skill levels of the players involved in a given game.

Data was accumulated through season 35 by various members of the Executive Council and massaged by Jason into a workable chart that would indicate what the starting scores should be if a 9 was playing a 12 (which might be different than if a 10 were playing a 13). Council member were looking at the number of turns it took for a given

player to get to an out (a double or a bull depending on the game) and then the number of turns used to actually hit the out. The idea was that this would provide a better indication of a person's "true handicap".

The sample size was admittedly very small and more data will be needed before we even consider a formal implantation in league play. The goal of this exercise was to gauge usability and user reaction. Can people use this? Do they like it?

There were some obvious complaints. The initial version was very hard to read but overall the response was positive. James Mathewson was the lone dissenting voice, feeling that using the chart was just an "extra pain in the ass" but over the course of the evening he did concede that the more his team used the chart, the easier it got.

Going forward the council will be collecting more data this season and handing out the new chart to the consolation tournament participants for further review.

Those of you who have other opinions on the matter (the chart itself) please come forward.

Divisions

We have 18 teams. One division makes for too long a season. The season would end August 30th.

9 & 9 adds too many off weeks or interdivisional matches (which introduce the variance in quality of opponents that may be considered unfair in some circles).

6 & 6 & 6 is the consensus.

How do we break it up? Some choices: by rough skill level (like we usually attempt to do), at random, an even distribution, strictly by team points per dart.

This being the "Summer" season the general mood of the council leans toward trying something a little different. We broke the teams into 6 groups of 3 teams based on perceived

ability. This meant that Jason's team and the Puppies (and somebody else) were in the first group and the three lowest-ranked teams were in the last group. The groups were then shuffled and a division was formed by blindly picking one roster from each pile.

The divisions for this season are Rocks, Papers and Scissors.

Rocks: Puppies, Whatever, Have Darts/Will Travel, Still Sticky, WET (Mann), Strokin'
Papers: PETA, Poke N Hope, TEAM 1, Dead Popes Society, Liquid Accuracy, DUP (Jones)

Scissors: CH Boyz, Acts of Dee-fiance, 2 Many Beers, Camped Out, Projectile Dysfunction, Banging Inside

The season will be a double round robin (10 matches). A Captains meeting will be held in the middle of the season on an "off" week. The last regular season matches will be held on July 12. Tournament play will begin July 19. The last (potential) match of the Consolation Tournament will be held August 9.

The Mug Tournament will invite 8 teams, the top 2 in each division and 2 wildcards based on total points scored in the season. The division winners will be seeded 1-3. All other seeding will be based on season points scored. There was some discussion of limiting the wildcards such that only one could come out of a given division. John Strobel and Jason Kilts were the only supporters of this idea.

The Consolation Tournament will invite the remaining 10 teams. Participation is, of course, optional. Seeds will be assigned based on season points. Teams will again be using the experimental handicap chart. Due to the greater number of participants this tournament could run longer than the Mug Tournament so the party date will accommodate this.

There will be a random drawing of pairings and a semi-random drawing for match sites. As with this past season the council will use its discretion in attempting to even out the randomness of the sites.

The MANDATORY Captains Meeting will be held June 7 (Tuesday) at Arnie's beginning at 7pm. A league sponsored Luck of the Draw tournament will follow as close to 8:30pm as possible. The BCDL will match the pot.

The Awards Banquet will be held the weekend of August 13-14. Social Director

Dee Marx is targeting the West End Tavern again but that remains tentative at this juncture.

Mike Litzsinger brought up for discussion the idea of tweaking the home field advantage by having the visiting team list first. After some discussion the consensus was to leave it as a blind listing.

Meeting adjourned at 10:45pm.
