Active Players on Roster

1. A team that had a full roster of 8 people but has lost a player, may request permission to replace that player. **At no time, however, may a team roster consist of more than 8 active players.** Teams may play up to 8 players per season, but only with the approval of the Executive Council (two-thirds approval vote of those Board members whose team is not involved in the player replacement) and as long their roster does not contain more than 8 active players. Any players replaced during the season are ineligible for League play for the remainder of the season.

The same procedural guidelines as for roster additions (Article VIII, B. 2. a-c) apply to requests for roster replacements.

Know the RULES and enjoy the game.

If it's NOT listed on the score sheet it didn't happen...

If in doubt, write it down...

Eligibility

Tournament:

A & C Division - 5 matches or 17 games

B Division (top 8) – 5 matches or 15 games

B Division (9th Place) - 4 matches or 14 games

Singles awards:

A & C Division - 12 games

B Division (top 8) – 11 games

B Division (9th Place) – 10 games

Overall awards:

A & C Division - 30 games

B Division (top 8) – 27 games

B Division (9th Place) – 24 games

Note - for a player to be eligible for league awards the player must meet the requirements for that category as outlined in the BCDL by Laws Article XIV: Awards.

Don't Do It

- ⇒ Don't use a player that has not been approved by the Executive Council (contact Pete Hall ahead of time) and paid for.
- ⇒ Don't use a player in Doubles or 701 who was not listed to play *and* present during singles.
- ⇒ Don't forget to properly fill out the handicap data on the scoresheet (repeated mistakes result in penalties).

⇒ Don't fill out a cricket scoreboard on the scoresheet while its game is still in progress. You know who you are, and so do we.

⇒ Don't forget to read the front page of the newsletter each week before you start the match.

⇒ Don't forget to contact Joyce P. Owens (League Statistician) in advance in case you need to reschedule a match.

⇒ Don't forget to be sportsmanlike, tip the bartender, and help clean up the empties.

⇒ Don't drink and attempt to drive.

Editor Notes

Packet drop off **Down Under Pub ONLY**.

Scoresheets:

Remember, it is the *winning* team that is responsible for getting their scoresheet to **Joyce P. Owens**. It must have a Wednesday postmark if mailed, or be faxed by Wednesday to avoid penalties. Current penalties for late scoresheets are 5 points for a Thursday postmark or fax, 8 points for a Friday postmark or fax, and all points thereafter. The losing team should keep their copy. If the winning scoresheet is lost, the losing team will only get their points if they can produce their copy. The home team is responsible for picking the packet up before the match. It is the responsibility of both teams to verify that all information on the scoresheet is correct.

If any team needs to add a player throughout the season, they must first have the Executive Councils approval. Captains need to contact **Pete Hall** to do this. Approval is required 72 hours prior to the first match played. After approval, the new person must then be paid for before they play.

Season 38 Scheduling Meeting

Meeting called to order – as much as any Jason Kilts-directed meeting is actually “called to order” – at 9pm. We've got perfect attendance from the council tonight.

Chairing is Jason Kilts. Transcribing is Jerry Shengulette. Bitching that everyone keeps taking her chair is Paula Brown. Lamenting the size of her breasts is Dee Marx. Casually drinking and politely not lamenting the size of Dee's breasts are Randy Wilcox and Pete Hall. Flitting in and out of the vicinity but still maintaining a presence in that way that only he can is John Strobel.

It's a light crowd from the general populace. I note Adom Lubitz and Anthony Jones paying rapt attention and a few other folks on the periphery, perhaps anticipating the start of the Luck-of-the-Draw.

Anybody want any rules changed? No. Should we keep All-Stars in the newsletter? Folks seem to like reading their names. We'll address it at the Captains Meeting. Perhaps we can do something with the criteria so that more people can read their names.

We have achieved the magic number of teams: 19. Mind you this is not “good” magic.

In preliminary banter, Jerry, Dee and John have nicely arranged three divisions in a 6x6x7 format. The idea would be that each division plays a double round robin and the smaller divisions incorporate some crossover matches (A v. B, B v. C, etc.)

In general folks don't like crossover matches. In this case there would have to be 4 of them for each team in a 6-team division. The potential for controversy if one team pulls 4 “easy” crossovers, while a close opponent pulls 4 “harder” crossovers weighs heavily against this option.

Next up for discussion is a “1 division of 9/1 division of 10” arrangement. As it happens, the teams we have break down best as 9 A teams and 10 B teams. This would entail a single round robin format in each division with the smaller division incorporating some bye weeks to make up the difference.

Another possibility, offered by Jason, is a 6x9x4 setup. A 6-team division would play a

double round robin (10 games). A 9-team division would play a single round robin with a bye and a position round (10 games). A 4-division team would play a triple round robin with a position round (10 games). Under this scenario the last place team in the 9-team division does not participate in the position round.

This idea was intriguing enough that it came to a vote (versus the 9x10 option).

Voting 6x9x4 were Randy, Dee, Pete and Jerry.
Voting 9x10 were Jason, John and Paula.

That decided the next order of business was to arrange the divisions. Things ended up as follows:

A – Dee, Boyz, Puppies, Jason, Strobel, Have Darts
B – Poke'N Hope, Whatever, More Cowbell, ATHF, Paula, P.D., Armed & Hammered, Thrill, Home by 11
C – Evolution, Strokin', Wall Bangers, Inside the Wire

The only real decision came down to which was the last team in A: Have Darts/Will Drink or Poke 'N Hope. Have Darts, having 2 council members, graciously offered to accept the appointment.

The position round format will be the same as last year: 1st hosts 2nd, 3rd hosts 4th, etc. Again, in the odd-team division(s), the last place team gets a second bye. The provision remains that a 3rd place team cannot "jump" a 2nd place team during the position round.

The tournament details are as follows:
9 teams in Mug Tournament
10 teams (optional) in Consolation

Division winners seeded 1-3.
Top 3 from A
Top 4 from B
Top 2 from C

B division season point totals will be prorated for 10 matches
Seeding by prorated season points.
In the Mug Tournament the lowest 2 seeds in play-in in the first round of the playoffs.
In the Consolation Tournament the lowest 4 seeds play 7v10, 8v9 (or as

appropriate dictated by number of actual participating teams).

Random pairings and random sites (with subtle massaging). For the record, Dee opposes the drawing for pairings. She's OK with the random sites.

The Captains Meeting is Feb 14 at Arnie's. Happy Valentine's Day.

Mar 21 is last week of the regular season.

Apr 18 is championship night.

Party is tentatively at the Tavern. Apr 22nd. 1-whenever.

This is an election season. Nobody from the current council is planning to run again!!!! We need to rock the vote.

Nominations will open at Captains Meeting. Nomination forms will be available there and also on the week 6 and 7 newsletters. Voting will take place during weeks 8 and 9. Election results will be published in week 10.

Just in case somebody doesn't get the message, we'll ask Joyce to put **THIS IS AN ELECTION SEASON** in every newsletter. Notice should be **BIG** (perhaps as big as the Cup Sale Ad somebody added.).

We're still ironing out the details for tee-shirt sales. Jerry to provide order requirement details to Paula Brown as soon as possible. Paula to create an order form for inclusion in the newsletter.

Depending on how things shake out with the details, we leaning toward \$12 and \$15 for short sleeve v. long sleeve.

Finally we got a budget report from Pete. We're more or less breaking even; the final number was \$25 something in the red due to need to pay for eFax capability.

Let's bring up paying the Treasurer at the Captain's meeting.

Meeting adjourned at 10:30pm.

ARTICLE III: THE EXECUTIVE BOARD

The Executive Board is composed of seven elected officers. Each elected member serves a one-year term, must be in good standing in the BCDL, and must be an active player in the current and/or previous season.

The Executive Board traditionally meets twice per season with the times and places chosen to accommodate the greatest number of Board members. A single location will be used for all Board Meetings, whenever possible. Meeting dates will be published in advance (at least two weeks, whenever possible). Meetings are open to any member of the League. Each season's Scheduling Meeting is the Executive Board meeting for that month. This is considered the first meeting. The second meeting is the Executive Board Meeting generally scheduled to occur just before the halfway mark of the current season. Other meetings may be scheduled as necessary.

Board members who are: 1) absent from two meetings (without due cause, as approved by the remainder of the Board) within their one-year appointment, or 2) fail to perform their duties to the satisfaction of the rest of the Board, will be relieved of their position. Replacements will be selected by the President, with a majority approval of the remainder of the Board. If an Executive Board member is not notified 72 hours in advance of an unscheduled, emergency meeting, their absence is excused. Any elected member of the Executive Board who is replaced because s/he did not serve at least six months of the one-year term, and/or was deemed by the remainder of the Executive Board to have failed to perform the duties of the office, is not eligible to run for office in the next election. No joint offices may be held by any member of the Executive Board.

A. Duties of the Executive Board shall include, but are not limited to:

1. By-Laws;

By-law changes will be effected by a two-thirds majority vote of board members. Whenever possible, proposed changes should be published at least two matches prior to the Board meeting at which the proposal will be decided. Barring "emergency" or "extraordinary" circumstances, all by-law changes will be instituted beginning with the following season.

2. Rules for Match Play;

Rules for Match Play for each season will be determined by majority vote of Executive Board members present at each season's Scheduling Meeting. Tie votes, should they occur, will be ruled in favor of the President. Any Rules for Match Play not

specifically determined at a given Scheduling Meeting will utilize the rule from the previous season. In addition, due to the time-consuming nature of the scheduling portion of the Scheduling Meeting for each season, the Executive Board may enact changes in the Rules for Match Play for the following season at any time during a given season (these changes should be published in the newsletter as soon as they have been decided).

Rules for Match Play may not be changed for the current season except under extraordinary circumstances (as determined by the President and Rules & Grievances Director) once a season has begun.

3. Determination of how league funds are to be spent;

4. Setting up special committees as necessary.

B. Members of the Executive Board, and each member's primary areas of responsibility, are:

(Note: Board members may utilize individuals or committees to assist in the successful completion of their duties, but the proper and timely execution of each duty remains the ultimate responsibility of that Board member.)

1. President - Duties include, but are not limited to:

a. Overseeing all League operations;

b. Acting as an ex-officio member of all committees;

c. Presiding over and setting agendas for Executive Board meetings and Captains' meetings;

d. Nomination of candidates to fill vacancies on the Executive Board;

e. Being a co-signer of the League bank account;

f. Presentation of awards at the End-of-the-Season Dart Party;

g. Coordination of activities with other leagues and organizations;

h. Attendance at meetings of larger scale organizations, such as the NCDO (North Carolina Dart Organization), TDC (Triangle Dart Council), etc.;

i. Update of League By-Laws and Rules for Match Play each season.

2. Vice-President - Duties include, but are not limited to:

a. Assuring compliance with League standards by host establishments;

b. Service as chief liaison between the BCDL and host establishments;

c. Acting as President, in the case of that officer's absence, disability, or removal.

In the case of the absence, disability, or removal of both the President and Vice-President, the following list has been adopted as a hierarchical ladder for succession of these offices:

i) President

ii) Vice-President

iii) Rules & Grievances Director

iv) Treasurer

v) Secretary

vi) Public Relations Director

vii) Social Director

3. Secretary - Duties include, but are not limited to:

a. Keeping minutes of all Executive Board Meetings (including proper records of how Executive Board members voted on all issues) and Captains' Meetings;

b. Providing a copy of the Executive Board and Captains' Meeting minutes and voting results (of all votes on proposals and rules changes) for publication in the newsletter the week following the meeting;

c. Providing a seasonal calendar for publication in the first newsletter each season of all scheduled Executive Board and Captains' Meetings.

4. Treasurer - Duties include, but are not limited to:

a. Handling all League financial matters;

b. Submission of a Treasurer's Report for publication in the newsletter twice per season;

c. Making funds available for disbursement as approved by the Executive Board;

d. Being bondable;

e. Maintenance of current records of all BCDL members, including names, addresses, and phone numbers;

f. Receipt of all League rosters, player information, and player dues at the registration meeting, as well as prior to the in-season addition or replacement of any League member;

g. Informing the Rules & Grievance Director of any player who has not paid dues before playing in a League match;

h. Contacting all other Executive Board members for their votes on additions and replacements to rosters after the close of the season's registration period, and then returning the decision of the Executive Board to the requesting team. These vote results on additions and replacements are also to be supplied to the Newsletter Editor for publication in the newsletter.

5. Rules & Grievances Director - Duties include, but are not limited to:

a. Settling all in-season matters involving Rules for Match Play;

b. Serving as the first person consulted regarding interpretations of the Rules for Match Play;

c. Levying penalties against League members or teams for Rules violations;

d. Receipt of all official League protests;

e. Calling and presiding over all Grievance/Protest meetings.

6. Social Director - Duties include, but are not limited to:

a. Organization of the end-of-the-season dart party.

7. Public Relations Director - Duties include, but are not limited to:

a. Coordination of publicity, advertising, etc.
