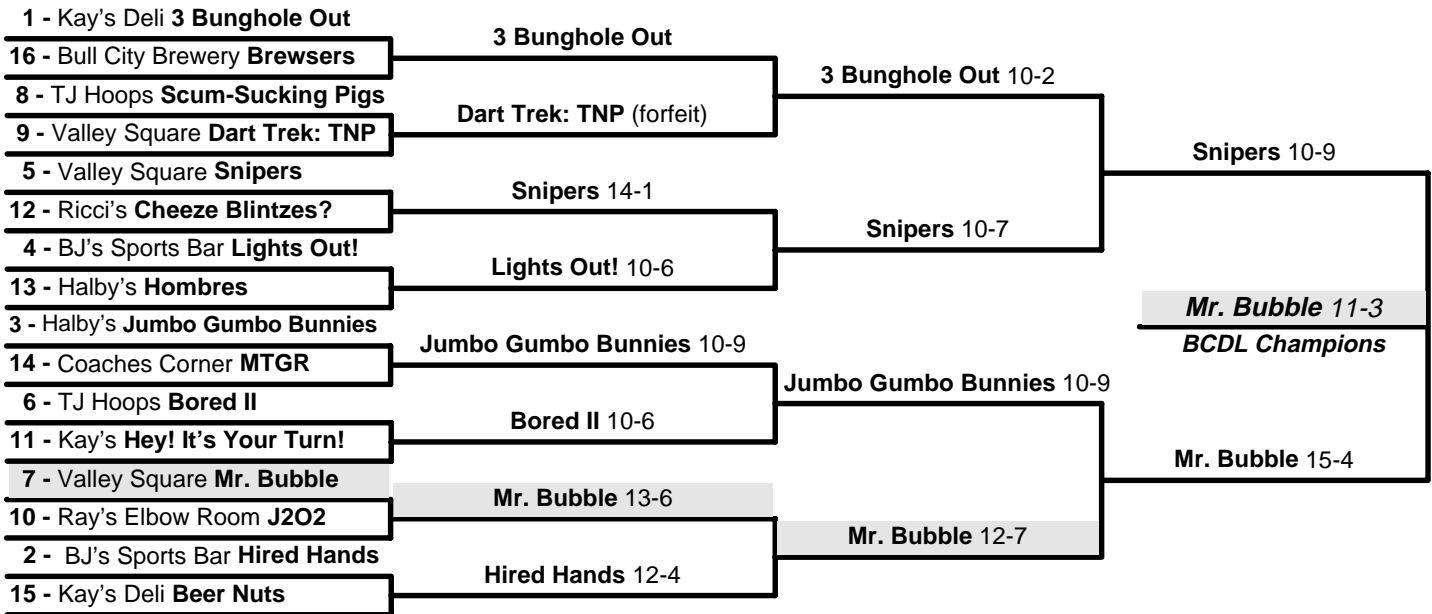

Welcome to the seventh season of the **Bull City Dart League**. This article contains important information for both returning and new league members. There are several minor changes this season.

Scoresheets:

Remember, it is the **winning** team that is responsible for returning the scoresheet with its envelope to **Halby's** no later than 8pm Wednesday. Please call Andy at home by 1am Tuesday, or by at work by 5pm on Wednesday if other arrangements must be made. Current penalties for late scoresheets are 5 points after 8pm Wednesday and 8 points after 5pm Thursday. The **home** team is responsible for picking the packet up before the match. It is the responsibility of **both** teams to verify that all information on the scoresheet is correct.

Handicaps:

There is one major change in the handicap system this season. When playing 301, Singles Cricket or **601**, you will multiply the difference in handicaps by 15. This is the same as it has always been. When playing Doubles Cricket or 4-Person 701, you will multiply the difference in handicaps by 10.

You will find a listing of all players who have participated in league play and their Point Per Dart Averages on page 3. The "Handicap" is the whole number of that average (10.01 to 10.99 are both "10".) Any player not listed is an 11.

Schedule:

Each division will play a double round-robin schedule, playing each divisional opponent at home and away. There will be **no** out of division matches this season.

BCDL standings are based on games won, not matches. After the teen week regular season, the top two teams from each division, and the next two teams based on total games won will qualify for the league championship tourney. The winner will be crowned league champions, and take possession of the league championship cup that will be held at Valley Square this season.

Questions? Help Available:

If you need help, or have a question, please call one of the league officers listed on the left. Just find their team on the schedule on the back, and call the appropriate bar.

Match Play Guidelines:

Each match begins at 8pm. Any team not having two players present by 8:05pm forfeits the match. The match is a "blind" list, each team takes turns listing their players for each section, keeping the scoresheet folded such that players listed for the other team are not visible.

The first section is **Singles 301**. Each team lists 4 players. During this section, both dart boards will be used with separate games taking place on each board. For purposes of calculating handicaps, the following information **must** be recorded for each game of 301: Each player's starting score (301, 316, 331, etc...), the number of points the losing player has left at the end, and the number of darts thrown by each player. In the **BCDL**, all '01 games are Single In, Double Out.

The second section is **Singles Cricket**. It is played on two boards as well. The following information **must** be recorded: Each player's starting score (0, 15, 30, etc...), each player's final point total, the number of darts thrown by each player, and what marks each player hit (please fill in the cricket boards on the back of the scoresheet.)

the final three sections are **Doubles 601**, **Doubles Cricket**, and **4-Person 701**. The doubles games are played on **two** boards unless **both** captains agree to use only one board. To be eligible to play any of these

games, a player must be present and listed to play in either 301 or Singles Cricket.

Important Change: When playing **Doubles Cricket** and **4-Person 701**, the handicap value is now **10** (ten) points!!!.

By-Laws and Rules for Match Play:

If your team does not have a copy of the League By-Laws, please contact Anita. The captain for each team should take one. This document is technical, and possibly, a little hard to understand at first. It should be used as a reference material. The best place to get answers to burning questions is other players.

New Players and Teams:

There will likely be many things that you are not sure about. Don't worry, just ask questions. This newsletter publishes all comments from the scoresheet. Your opponents or teammates with league experience should help explain what "All-Stars" are, what "PPD" means, etc... If all else fails, don't hesitate to call one of the league officers for help.

Bull City Brewery and Nightclub, 115 N Duke St. This is the same structure that housed the Weeping Radish, The French Quarter, and Old Heidelberg Village. The Brewery is new to the league, and they currently have four boards in addition to the brewing vats and fine menu.

Coaches Corner, 2510 University Dr., Eric Herndon. This is at the site of the old Rockwood Filling Station, where Business

Coaches Corner, 2510 University Dr., Eric Herndon. This is at the site of the old Rockwood Filling Station, where Business 15-501 merges with University Drive, across from the Piece Goods Shop. Coaches has a good, open configuration with four boards and one pool table. The menu is good, too. We just finished our first season under new ownership.

Halby's Restaurant, 1201 University Dr (Forest Hills Shopping Center), Joe Halby. Halby's is located just off the Durham Freeway; it is also at the southern end of Duke Street and Vickers (Gregson) Street. Halby's will be the scoresheet packet pickup and dropoff point for the spring

season. Halby's has a good menu and two dart boards.

Kay's Deli & Pub, 1725 Carpenter Fletcher Rd Suite 106, Kay Lussier. Kay's is located on the corner of Alston Avenue, just over the railroad tracks from NC Hwy 55 and Ray's Elbow Room. Kay's features a full menu, a couple billiards tables, and six dart boards; four of which are currently in match condition.

Ray's Elbow Room, NC HWY 55. Ray's is new this season. Ray's hosts a volleyball league during warmer seasons. There are also a couple of pool tables squeezed in among the four dart boards.

Rick's Sports Lounge, out past where Holloway becomes 98. This is a new establishment to the league. Let's hope they have a fun season.

Valley Square Billiards, 3219A Chapel Hill Rd, Kem Lunsford. Valley Square is located behind Piper's Deli on Chapel Hill Road, just up from University Drive. It is less than a mile from Southsquare Mall. Valley Square has four boards as well as several billiard tables.
