### Captains' Meeting Notes

Kay's Deli, June 18, 1997

A meeting was called Wednesday, June 18 at Kay's to discuss the single issue which was tabled at the Captains' meeting held June 11. To recap, The Executive Council passed (by a 6-0 vote) the following motion at its meeting of June 8: "Rich Little put forth a motion to notify Anita Tyndall that the Council will discuss this debt with the league members, or their representatives, at the Captains' Meeting scheduled for Wednesday, June 11. This is to allow her additional time to produce documentation for the expenditures. If no satisfactory answer is given, the Council will ask Anita to step down as Vice President." At the June 11th meeting, Jerry MacNabb put forth a motion, that was passed, to table this issue for one week to give the captains time to consider the information.

Last Wednesday the question was put to Anita again and her response was that she withdrew the money by counter check and gave it to the newsletter editor as requested by the editor. The newsletter editor was not in attendance at this meeting and had resigned to Anita sometime Monday night. Before the Captains present were asked to vote on the Council's motion, Anita Tyndall resigned from her position as Vice President stating that this move did not imply any wrong doing on her part. Open discussion was held to find ways to increase security of the league's possessions. This included limiting access to the PO Box and also writing checks directly to Kinko's rather than the newsletter editor.

### Executive Council Meeting

The Executive Council held an emergency meeting on short notice after the Captains' meeting Wed. June 18 at Kay's. The current vacancies of the Vice-Presidency, Statistician, and Newsletter Editor were the hot topics. Andy Mead volunteered to finish out the season filling in as Statistician and Editor. It is the intention of the Council to place an ad in the newsletter for all three positions.

Andy also put forth a motion that the \$200 which was advanced to Patrick at the beginning of the season be

considered payment due for services rendered by the statistician and editor for the 1997 summer season. Council members present voted: 5 for, and 0 against.

The Shackers of D Division submitted a player request to Sam Lamson which was approved. However, the approved player has never played, Jim Hall was substituted illegally. Unfortunately, the statistician at that time entered Jim Hall as a new player although he hadn't been approved. This error continued for several weeks before the Council caught up with it. Andy put forth a motion stating that the Shackers be penalized for each match Jim Hall played in. Council voted: 1 for (Little), and 4 against (Mead, Paradis, Brown, and Lamson)

Andy then moved that the Shackers be penalized for the first match Jim Hall participated in but not for the following matches. Council voted: 4 for (Brown, Lamson, Mead, Paradis), and 1 against (Little).

Tom Brown was appointed Bull City Dart League representative to the Triangle Dart Council.

### Duties of the Vice-President

Here follows the duties and responsibilities of the BCDL Vice-President. The first four items are general to all members of the Executive Council. The last three are specific to the Veep.

#### 1. By-Laws;

By-law changes will be effected by a two-thirds majority vote of board members. Proposed changes should be published at least two matches prior to the Board meeting at which the proposal will be decided. Barring "emergency" or "extraordinary" circumstances, all by-law changes will be instituted beginning with the following season.

#### 2. Rules for Match Play;

Rules for Match Play for each season will be determined by majority vote of Executive Board members present at each season's Scheduling Meeting. Tie votes, should they occur, will be ruled in favor of the President. Any Rules for Match Play not specifically determined at a given Scheduling Meeting will utilize the rule from the previous season. In addition, due to the time-consuming nature of the scheduling portion of the Scheduling Meeting for each season, the Executive Board may

enact changes in the Rules for Match Play for the following season at any time during a given season (these changes should be published in the newsletter as soon as they have been decided).

Rules for Match Play may not be changed for the current season except under extraordinary circumstances (as determined by the President and Rules & Grievances Director) once a season has begun.

3. Determination of how league funds are to be spent;
4. Setting up special committees as necessary.
  - a. Assuring compliance with League standards by host establishments;
  - b. Service as chief liaison between the BCDL and host establishments;
  - c. Acting as President, in the case of that officer's absence, disability, or removal.

### **BCDL By-Laws Article IV Statistician & Editor**

The Statistician and Newsletter Editor are appointed by, and serve at the discretion of, the Executive Board. They may be replaced at any time by a two-thirds majority of the Executive Board. The Statistician and Newsletter Editor are expected to attend all Executive Board meetings.

Provided that the League Statistician and Newsletter Editor perform their duties to the satisfaction of the Executive Board, each office will be paid a set portion of each League member's seasonal dues. As of the summer, 1997 season, this amount will be \$3 per member for each of these two paid positions.

- A. The duties of the **League Statistician** shall include, but are not limited to:
1. Maintenance of weekly and seasonal statistics for the League;
  2. Providing said statistics to the Newsletter Editor for publication in a timely manner;
  3. Maintenance of archival, machine-readable records of League statistics during tenure; and transfer of said records to succeeding League Statistician;

4. Designation of central location(s) for the distribution and return of weekly Match packets;
  5. Collection of weekly returned packets at the announced deadline;
  6. Making all reasonable effort (in conjunction with the League Statistician) to ensure that Matches rescheduled for play prior to normal Match night are provided with current player statistics and a scoresheet for said Match (if not the entire current newsletter);
  7. Prompt verification of any changes in team rosters with League Treasurer and Newsletter Editor;
  8. Notifying Rules & Grievance Director and Newsletter Editor of any late/incomplete return packets;
  9. Generation of League Season schedules based on the Rules for Match Play and submission of said schedule to the Executive Council for approval;
  10. Procurement of Seasonal awards and trophies;
  11. Officiation (in conjunction with the Newsletter Editor) of League elections, or appointment of an Election Committee in the event that either of these appointed members choose to run for office;
  12. Completion of any other duties (within reason) that may, from time to time, be designated by the Executive Board.
- B. The duties of the **League Newsletter Editor** shall include, but are not limited to:
1. Publication of weekly official League newsletter of record;
  2. Production of newsletter, scoresheets and weekly packets;
  3. Selection and oversight of Newsletter staff, if a staff is utilized;
  4. Delivery of said newsletters, scoresheets and packets to the designated distribution site(s) no later than 6:30 p.m. on the evenings of Match play;
  5. Making all reasonable effort (in conjunction with the League Statistician) to ensure that Matches rescheduled for play prior to normal Match night are provided with current player statistics and a scoresheet for said Match (if not the entire current newsletter);
  6. Reporting all decisions of the Executive Board and/or Captains' Meetings regarding League operation or Match Play;
  7. Publication of all official news from the Executive Board;

8. Actively solicit articles for the newsletter from the League membership;
9. Editing and confirmation of veracity of any material submitted for publication;
10. Officiation (in conjunction with the League Statistician) of League elections, or appointment of an Election Committee in the event that either of these appointed members choose to run for office;
11. Publication, in a timely fashion, of the results of said elections;
12. Publication of all other League documents including, but not limited to, League By-Laws, Rules for Match Play, fliers, election ballots, statistics for publication in other media, etc.;
13. Maintenance of archival, machine-readable records of League publications and statistics during tenure and transfer of said records to succeeding League Newsletter Editor;
14. Completion of any other duties (within reason) that may, from time to time, be designated by the Executive Board.

### **Practical Skills**

The Statistician needs to have access to a computer that can run DOS programs. The ability to easily transfer data to the Editor is also a must. Andy Mead will set you up with the software and the training.

The Editor needs to have some experience using a computer-based word processor (Microsoft Word, WordPerfect, Aldus Pagemaker, etc...). The ability to import the statistics from the Statistician is needed. A good printer is also needed. Time to go to Kinko's every week is also needed. Andy Mead can supply some sample Microsoft Word newsletters to plagiarize.

### **Tourney Reminders**

**If you think your team is going to make the playoffs, make sure that you write down a contact phone number (that has an answering machine) on the back of tonight's scoresheet.**

The tournament schedule will be announced as soon as tonight's scores are in. First week matches will be scheduled at the home of the four first place teams.

**Bull City Dart Team Update**

Hey, it's time for another update of the **North Carolina City Dart League** (NCCDL). Basically, that's the current city challenge team league. The current format provides for play about every four to six weeks against one of the other eight leagues across the state, with the entire schedule spanning a calendar year.

**Raleigh 23 Durham 15**

The Bull City's third match of the year took place at Woody's Sports Bar in Cary on May 10th against **Raleigh**, a team which had not lost a match to anyone in any format of play in several years. Of course, Raleigh is the defending NCCDL champion and Durham was considered a serious underdog heading into this road match. Playing for Durham were: Tom Brown, Don Butman, John Carpenter, Norm Jackson, Jason Kilts, Mark Knight, Todd Lemons, Andy Mead, Mike Seward, and Scott VanMeter. Current and former BCDL players who were throwing for Raleigh were: Randy Hirneisen, Steve Hoffmann, and Timothy Lane.

The BCDL team held its own in the singles 301 set, finishing the set with a tie score of 4-4. Winning for Durham were: Butman and Knight (each in two-straight games), Kilts and Seward. Also of note was Brown's 10-dart game in a fantastic set with Bill Carver.

Durham fell behind in singles cricket, as we only pulled 3 out of the 8 possible points. Winning for Durham were Brown, Butman, and Lemons (all in two-straight).

Both doubles sets were split 2-2 to send the match to the four-player set with the Raleigh team ahead 17-15. In doubles 501, the pairs of Carpenter/Jackson (who basically are the reigning doubles -01 kings of BCDL league play) [Ed. I think Huge Findlay and ghost wear

that crown, now] and Mead/Seward (with both pairs winning in two-straight). In doubles cricket, the winning pairs for Durham were Carpenter/Jackson (again) and Seward/VanMeter (the second pair being in two-straight).

So the Durham squad had to pull out both 701 sets to win the match. After both four-man teams won the first game of their sets for Durham, we actually **had the lead against Raleigh during the final set of the match**. The Durham team only had to split the final four games to come out on top against the state's premier team. Alas, Raleigh showed *why* they are the state's premier team, and they swept the last four games to win both sets and provide the final score of 23-15.

Winning records for the Durham team belonged to: Mike Seward (3-2), Don Butman (2-1), and Jason Kilts (1-0). The loss dropped the Durham squad to 7th of the 9 teams in the state at 1-2 with 52 points (a standing which is a bit deceptive due to Durham having a bye already and also having played two of the top three teams in last year's standings).

### Durham 29 Chapel Hill 9

The Bull City team's fourth match of the year was against our top geographic rival, **Chapel Hill**. Captain Kilts brought out nearly the entire Durham team for this match, since everyone wants to get a little piece of their #1 rival. The match took place on June 7th at the Durham team's home establishment, PJ's Sports Bar.

Playing for Durham were: Tom Brown, Don Butman, John Carpenter, Norm Jackson, Dennis Keever, Jason Kilts, Mark Knight, Todd Lemons, Andy Mead, Kyle Mills, Mike Seward, Kevin Staring, Will Tan, Tim Thaggard, and Scott VanMeter. Chapel Hill players who are current or former BCDL members were: Dale Christianer, Don Moore, Sean O'Brien, Tom Smith, and Frank Telesz.

Chapel Hill jumped to a quick 1-0 lead after Don Moore pitched a 115-Out in his 2-games-to-1 win over Kyle Mills, despite a league-high tying 120-In by Kyle. Durham rolled on to win the last 7 points of the set with wins by Kilts, Thaggard, Butman, and Lemons (all in two-straight), as well as wins by Tan, Brown, and Staring.

The singles cricket set was split 4-4 with Carpenter, Butman, Brown, and Jackson winning for Durham (all in two-straight). After singles, Durham thus had a lead of 11-5.

Durham took 3 out of 4 in both doubles sets to convincingly clinch the win before the final set. In doubles 501, winning for Durham were the pairs of

Butman / Tan (two-straight), Carpenter / Jackson (two-straight, and only taking about a total of five minutes), and Brown/Lemons. In doubles cricket, the winning Durham duos were Tan / Knight, Kilts / Butman, and Brown / Lemons (all in two-straight).

Though the match win was already decided, the 701 set is still part of the match, just like here in league play. To add a little gravy on the victory, Durham took both of those 3-point sets too, to provide a final score of 29-9. The winning groups for Durham were Knight/Carpenter / Jackson / Thaggard (in 2-straight) and Brown / Butman / Mead / VanMeter.

Top achievements for Durham were: Tom Brown (5-0 and a 9mark), Don Butman (5-0), Todd Lemons (3-0), John Carpenter (3-0), Will Tan (3-0), Norm Jackson (3-0), Jason Kilts (2-0), and Tim Thaggard (2-0).

The updated standings are not available quite yet, but this rather definitive victory moved Durham to 2-2 and into at least 6th place of 9 teams in the state, and very probably into 5th or even 4th. Chapel Hill dropped to 0-5 on the season and remains mired in last place.
